



# Psychometric Testing

Psychometric testing for children, young people and adults delivered by registered psychologists at Hopefield.

## Cognitive Assessments (WISC-V & WAIS-IV)

Assesses cognitive development in children aged between 4-16 years and adults. Provides a comprehensive evaluation of an individual's intellectual ability, the presence of any weaknesses or strengths, providing information for children presenting with behavioral difficulties and assessing eligibility for educational services and/or support plans.

## NEPSY-II

Eight neuropsychological assessments used with children to assist with identifying attention, concentration, planning and organisation difficulties.

## Academic Achievement (WIAT-III)

Designed to assess and individuals aptitude for reading, mathematics, writing and oral language. Usually administered when there is evidence of a number of difficulties such as poor academic results, behavioral difficulties, poor attention and/or dis-engagement in tasks.

Psychometric Testing can be useful for:

- Identifying cognitive strengths, learning potential and acquired academic skills.
- Identify the presence of specific learning difficulties, and attention & concentration problems.

Hopefield is licensed to administer tests using Q-Interactive (an on-line format) reducing both assessment and outcomes wait time.
